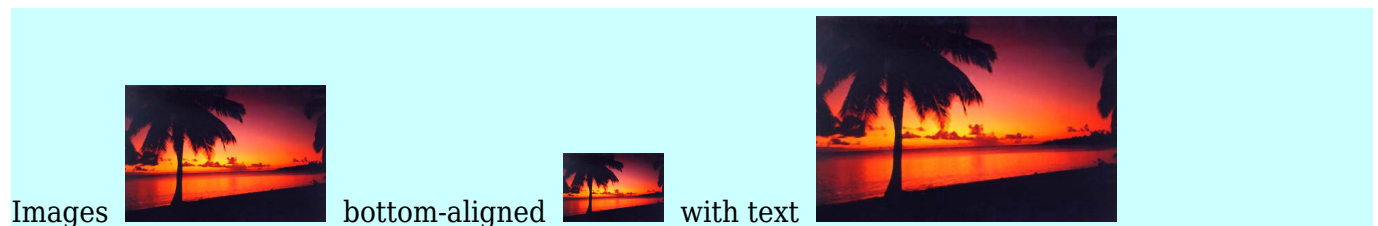
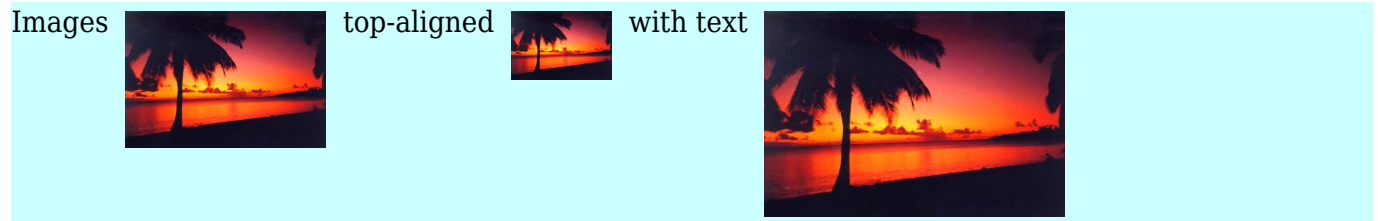

## Image Alignment

When printing in-line images, the whole line is vertically aligned to to the biggest image. This includes the top/bottom margin of the image. In the original mPDF v1.x this was set to 0.2em; by chance this neatly aligned the text to look as though it was perfectly inline with the bottom or top of the image. The default setting in v2+ is 0.5em (to be consistent with HTML standards) and the alignment is not so good.

This example sets a CSS style of `img { margin: 0.3em; }`
